MAASE recommends that districts be reimbursed for 100% of the state-mandated services provided to families and their children from birth through age three. Research is clear: an investment in preventative early childhood services pays long-term dividends.

Michigan has mandated that districts provide services and supports to families and their children, birth through age three, with developmental delays.

Michigan is one of only five states that provides mandated services for children and their families in this age range.

Unlike any other state, funding intended for Michigan's K-12 system is diverted to provide these mandated services.
