## Notes:

- What is the problem of practice?
  - o Personal Curriculums
    - Students who receive resource room programming
    - · Personal Curriculums are being used to help students meet graduation requirements
    - Modified Standards are an individual decision
    - Suggestions:
      - curriculum modification decision making tools/resources
    - o Early Elementary Behavior
      - Significant behavioral issues, challenge to maximize time in general education
        - Challenging for general education teachers
          - There is also a tipping point for special education staff
      - Consensus the students that have the highest needs in early elementary are students who have not had a preschool experience
      - Suggestions:
        - regularly scheduled team meetings with teachers, paras, consultants to review plans, data and problem solve
          - o district committed resources for subs to ensure meeting time
        - build relationships with kindergarten students, first two weeks of school are important and staff are not allowed to be in the office
  - o District Continuum and Regional/ISD Continuum
    - Discussion on a smaller districts philosophy to keep students in the local district
    - Discussion on larger districts and a "buffet" of options, more fluid movement between programs
    - Suggestions:
      - Data based decision on Educational Benefit to determine LRE
      - There is a need for effective data in the PLAAFP and in Progress Reports

- o Certificate of Completion
  - Elective credit options are decreasing
  - CTE has increased rigor, they are able to accommodate but not modify
  - Discussion on the value of a Certificate of Completion, what careers options are truly available
  - Suggestions:
    - Increased staff support in elective credits
    - Project Search
