- *"Appropriate Instruction" do we have a student problem or a 'what we do all day' problem?
- *Discussion: analogy of educational diagnostics/medical diagnostics
- *You can't argue with THE DATA
- *Simple question: How does this student compare to his/her classroom peers?
- *Students that are 'low across the board' do we call them LD because they're not responding?
- *What level of intervention is needed what intensity level and how specific?
- *Florida legislates only MTSS for identification for LD mandated 12 weeks of data intervention before moving forward
- *Frustration with NOT using the MTSS model: what do we do?
- *Power of working with gen ed teachers to do differentiated instruction
- *Differences between elementary/middle/HS levels and how we culture, nurture, meet students needs
- -how this impacts evaluation
- *Data drops amount of time to get data is HUGE (issues: i.e. missing instruction)
- -how do we support locals to get good data about interventions without impacting instruction time?
- ~Building flexibility into the schedule
- ~NWA 3x a year
- ~The data is an issue are we looking at the RIGHT data if the schedule allows us the time?
